Assisteens General Information Summary

Arcadia Assisteens is an auxiliary organization of the Assistance League® of Arcadia that provides leadership and community service opportunities for high school students.

Minimum Membership and Volunteer Requirements and Responsibilities:

- Support/attend membership events (Snowball Munch, Movie Night, Membership Tea, etc.)
- Monthly Meetings – Generally the first Monday of the month September through June
- Bargain Box Thrift Shop – three-3 hour shifts
- Book Buddies – two-2 hour shifts
- Operation School Bell – one 2 hour shift
- Bargain Box Holiday Sale Preparations – one 2 hour shift
- Dinner Committee – once a year at a monthly meeting
- Halloween Happenings OR Thanksgiving Shopping – one 2 hour shift
- Holiday Caroling – once a year
- See's Candy Fundraiser – once a year
- Email – Read and respond to communications and Bulletins
- New Members Only:** training for Bargain Box and Book Buddies and 3 hours of New Member Activities

Financial Obligations:

- Annual dues (\$80 new members, \$55 returning members)
- Shared cost of one dinner committee: approximately \$25 per committee member
- Incidental costs may include providing an occasional pot luck dish at an activity, small cost to attend a social activity, or purchasing an optional sweatshirt.
